Promotion Testing and Evaluation Process

Mission Statement

Introduction

The goal of the testing process is to provide a positive experience to our students by establishing what is expected of them when testing for advancement. When the students are ready to test for their next rank, they must meet the minimum requirements listed in the OCJTC Promotion Guidelines and Requirements.

Promotion Board

The promotion board will consist of the Head Judo Instructor and selected senior instructors.

Testing and Evaluation

The promotion board members will evaluate the students’ technical skills, general knowledge, attitude and preparedness. The testing will consist of OCJTC Promotion Guidelines’ predefined set of skills and knowledge. The students must demonstrate the predefined set of skills and articulate Judo history, philosophy and knowledge before the Promotion Board. The students must also have completed the required classes, certifications, and time in rank.

Testing Results

Recommendation for advancement to the next rank will be based on approval of the Promotion Board. The head instructor will have the final and overriding authority for promotion to the next rank.

The test results and recommendation of the Promotion Board will be given at the conclusion of the testing process. Once notified, a date will be set for the promotion ceremony. All promotions will take effect on the date of the promotion ceremony.
